






How to search for eBooks at RCC Library

We have two ways to accomplish this. The most common is through our **Richland Library Catalog**. The other is through the **EBSCOhost database – eBook Collection**. This outline will discuss how to access both of these options.

Reading the book online is only to give you time to decide if you want to download (borrow) the book.

If you try to do anything other than read, you will get an option to download.



Then you will be asked if you have **Adobe Digital Editions**

You have to have this to download the book, so if you haven't done it on your device, choose get Adobe Digital Editions. **It is FREE**

Follow the download instructions.

After that, go back to this page and choose **Done with this step**



You will need Adobe Digital Editions

Adobe Digital Editions is required to download books. This free software is different from Adobe Reader.

A free Adobe ID is also required to transfer the book to another device. It is not required to read books on this computer.


Get Adobe Digital Editions

Once you download the book, it will tell you how much time is left on your loan.

Loan periods are for 7 days. When that time is up you cannot access the book without downloading it again.

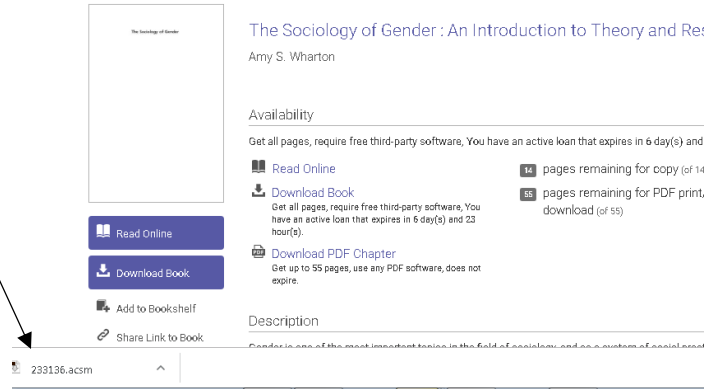

You need to open the download.

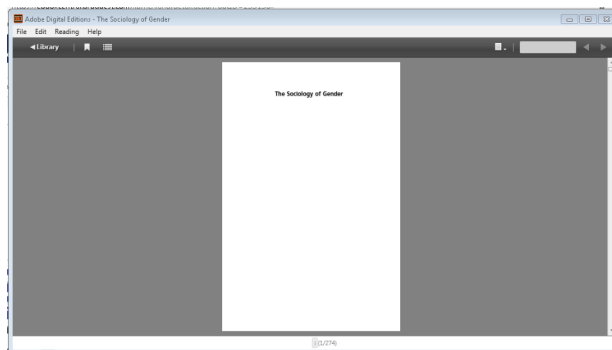
It will be at the bottom of the screen after you choose download.

Or in your download folder on your device.



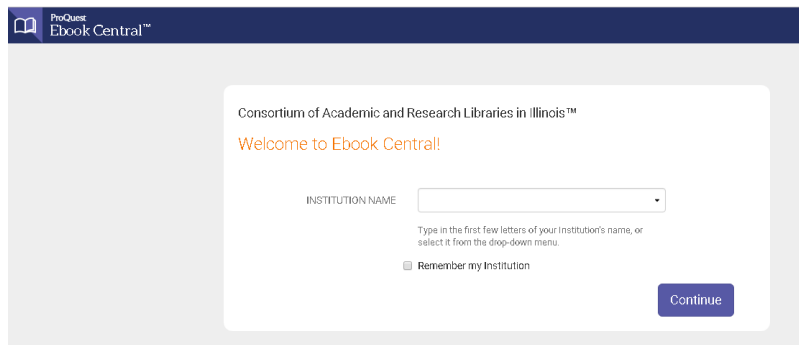
When you open the download it will open into the Adobe Digital Editions app.

However, you can only read the book here, not make notes etc.



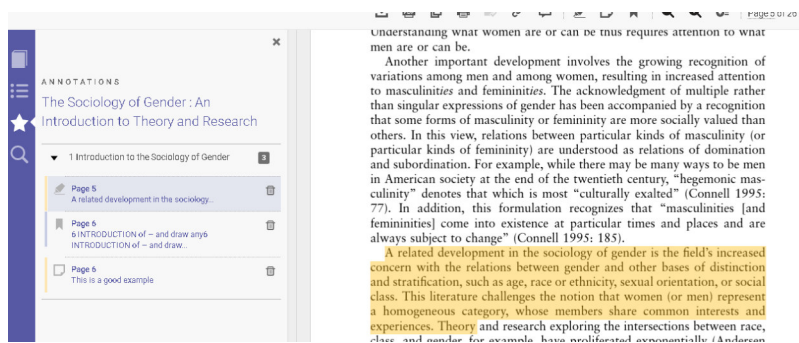
When you open the book through **Proquest eBook** (where you found the book)

You can make notes, highlights etc. They will still be there if you have to check it out again.





You can find your notes with the star (annotations) on the left.

Also if you borrow the book again, the notes will still be there for you.

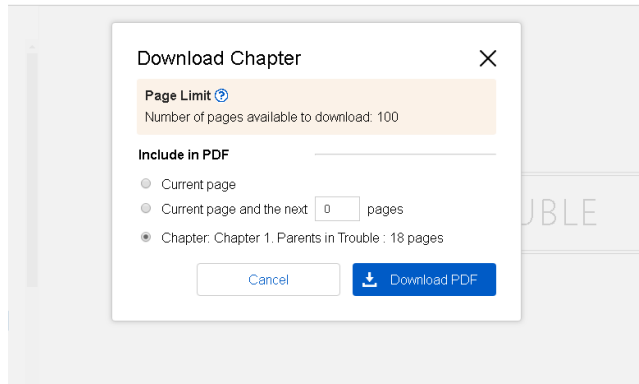

How to search for eBooks at RCC Library

In the PDF Full Text mode you can download chapters or certain pages.

There is a limit that changes with each book.

You can print/save up to the page limit.



Download the eBook is actually borrowing it like in the other app.

You must make a My EBSCOhost account.

You choose the sign in / create account and follow the directions
